- Eligibility:**
1. Current Youth member in good standing of USBC.
 2. Jr. Gold Qualifier Eligibility: Must be a current Jr. Gold member, in good standings, prior to the beginning of Tournament play.

Entry Fee: \$110.00 per bowler. This is a Scratch Event on a single sport shot.

Advancement ratio to national: 1 per 5 entries. No major fraction used.

Postmark after Dec. 18 deadline there will be a \$5.00 late charge. Call for availability after Dec. 18.

PLUS a \$100 scholarship, based on 5 bowlers.

You may **ONLY** enter this event once.

If a fractional amount of money is left in a division, the first non-qualifying bowler in that Division **MAY** advance if they pay the difference between the overage and entry fee.

Minimum of 5 bowlers needed to conduct a division.

Tournament Format:

There MAY be multiple divisions, boys any age/average and girls any age/average.
Minimum of 5 bowlers each needed to conduct a U18 division.
In the event there are NOT 5 girls or 5 boys, all bowlers will be in a single Uni-sex U18 division.

The same applies to other age divisions, If we cannot field an age Division, they will be moved to the next higher valid Division.

THIS EVENT is U18, U16, U14, U12 (assuming at least 5 bowlers in a div. squad). If you win a spot, the following indicates the division you would be assigned to for national finals.

Any bowler whose birth date is: 8/1/13 or later U12
8/1/11 - 7/31/13 U14
8/1/09 - 7/31/11 U16
8/1/07 - 7/31/09 U18

We may NOT be running a specific division for U18 / U16 / U14 / U12. It depends on number of participants by age bracket.

Participants compete on a “scratch” basis.
Each participant will bowl 5 games changing lanes each game.
High 5-game total will determine winners.

**Winners get a paid entry into the 2026 Junior Gold Championships July 11-18, 2026
Minneapolis, MN PLUS a \$100 scholarship, based on 5 bowlers.**

We will start with 1 division, then expand additional division as 5 boys and/or 5 girls are entered

As we get additional multiples per division, additional spots will be purchased for that Division.

If the winner has a GOLD Spot, they receive the Scholarship and the spot goes to next bowler.

Ties:

In the event of ties for the last available spot in a division, the highest 5th game rolled will break the tie, and work back from there by game until the tie is broken.

Fractional spots:

If a fractional amount of money is left in any division, the first non-qualifying bowler in that division can advance if they pay the difference between the overage and the cost for the entry. If that bowler chooses not to purchase the spot, it CANNOT be offered to anyone else. Extra money could be divided as additional money for awarded scholarships in that division from the event. Same tie rules would apply, if needed.

Protests:

All rules not covered here will be covered by USBC tournament rules. The Tournament Director shall handle all protests. The decision of the Tournament Director shall be final unless an appeal is filed within 72 hours in accordance with USBC Rules.

Athletes can only be awarded one entry into the national event.
